



### **The following are the truck requirements for our 3 or 4 yard trailer:**

- $\frac{3}{4}$  Ton (2500, 250) or 1 Ton (3500, 350)
- The  $\frac{3}{4}$  ton is your MINIMUM requirement with a diesel recommended. Also, check with the make/model maximum towing capacity (up to 14,000 pounds needed)
- The 1 ton diesel dually (6 total tires/wheels) will be your best ride and provide the most muscle.
- A two wheel drive will give you better pulling capacity and ride than a 4 wheel drive. However, if you are in a cold climate, the 4 wheel drive will be more useful year round.
- Some more advanced curbing operations will use a heavy duty 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ton or 2 ton truck with a dump box on the rear for sod and waste disposal (can get expensive, yet very useful).
- Whatever truck you buy MUST be equipped with an electric brake box. This activates your electric brakes on each wheel of your trailer.
- Whatever truck you buy MUST be equipped with the proper towing package. You must have a hitch with a ball size of 2  $\frac{5}{16}$  and strong enough to pull up to 14,000 pounds (GVWR).

### **The following are the truck requirements for our 2 yard trailer:**

- $\frac{1}{2}$  Ton (1500, 150)
- The  $\frac{1}{2}$  ton is your MINIMUM requirement. Diesel is not necessary and usually not an option in  $\frac{1}{2}$  tons.
- Check with the make/model maximum towing capacity (up to 6,000 pounds needed).
- Whatever truck you buy MUST be equipped with an electric brake box. This activates your electric brakes on each wheel of your trailer.
- Whatever truck you buy MUST be equipped with the proper towing package. You must have the proper hitch and ball size (call for size) for up to 6,000 pounds (GVWR).
